

How to bring an "Au Pair" in Luxembourg

I/ Agreement from the Ministry of Youth.

Specific conditions required to [be a young au pair](#):

- be **at least 18** and less than 30 years old (girl and boy);
- hold a certificate giving them access to higher education in their country of origin, or give proof that they have attended class until the age of 17 at the minimum;
- have basic knowledge of the languages spoken by the host family, as well as English or one of the country's 3 administrative languages (German, French or Luxembourgish);
- provide a medical certificate established less than 3 months prior to their arrival, proving that the young au pair is able to carry out simple routine family tasks, including childcare;
- have concluded an **au pair hosting agreement** with an authorized host family;
- **not carry out any salaried or independent work** during their time as an au pair.

II/ Application for a temporary authorization to stay

The application for a “temporary authorization to stay” must contain the applicant's **identity details** (surname(s), first name(s) and address in the country of residence) and must be accompanied by the following documents and information:

- a certified copy of their valid passport, in its entirety;
- a birth certificate;
- a **copy of the police record** or an affidavit (sworn oath) established in the country of residence;
- The agreement of the Luxembourgish Minister in charge of Youth;

III/ Stay permit application

- Declaration of arrival
- Medical check
- Residence permit application
